Good attendance in general, with Ol attending most meetings 8 out of 12 and Al & Kim attending 3 of 12 meetings.

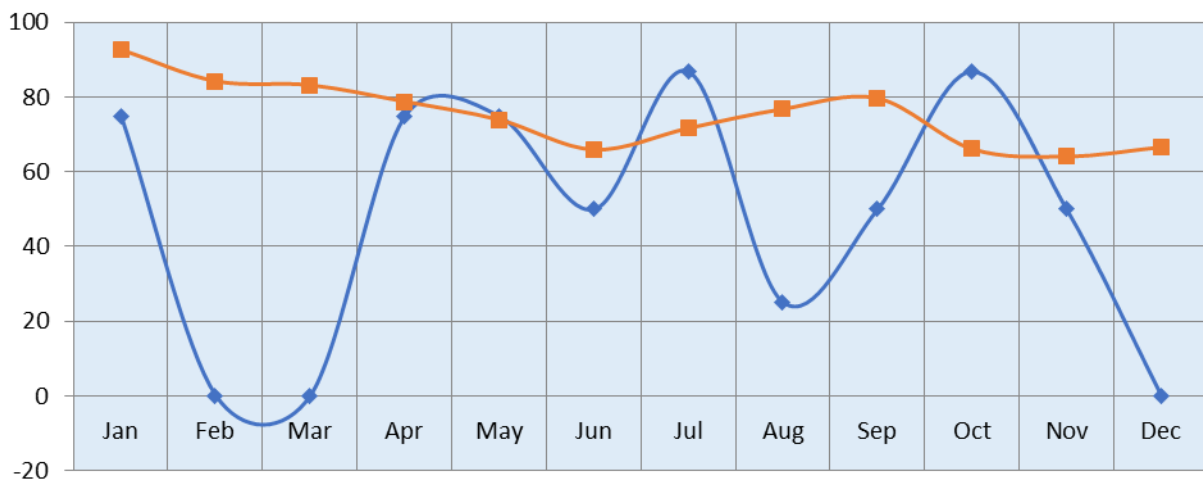

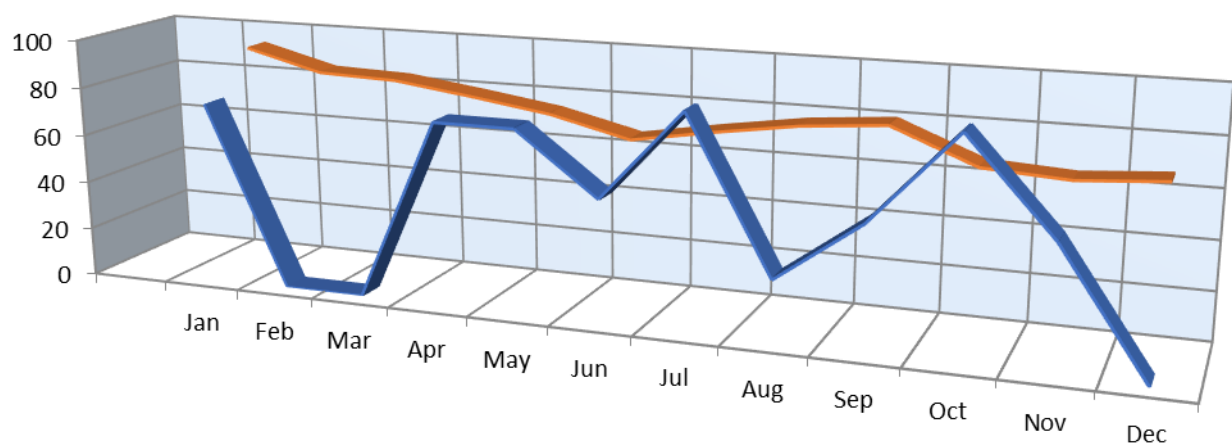
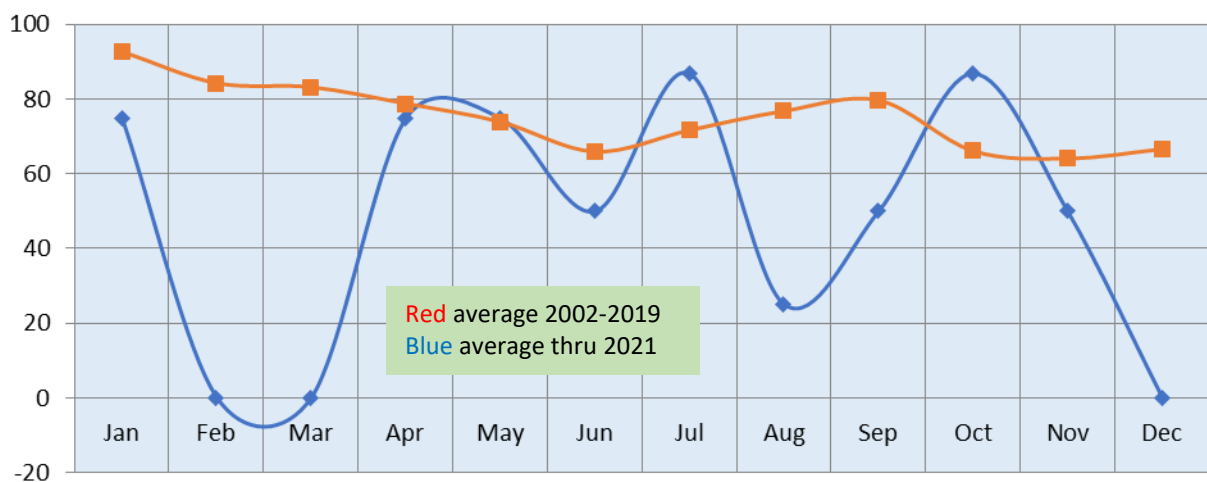
